There a number of expectations in which the combined Associations of Tamworth, Gunnedah, Bingara, Coonabarabran and Warialda expect of players, parents and officials in the lead up and throughout the tournament in Coffs Harbour.

- 1. Tournament dates are: Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October to Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 and is held at the C-Ex Coffs International Stadium, Stadium Drive, Coffs Harbour. Parents are to book their accommodation, and organise travel to and from Coffs Harbour.
- 2. The Player Levy, Registration and Gear Order will be done on the OES website and must be finalised by **Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> June**.
- 3. The Player Registration fee is **\$225 per player**. This includes tournament fees, uniform (shorts or tights, playing shirt and admin levy. Players can order extra merchandise, see gear on OES website.
- 4. Payment is non-refundable, (although registration fee, \$80 will be returned). Shadow players are requested to pay the full registration and have the option to keep uniform and get rego refunded or the full amount refunded if not selected.
- 5. Players are to respect the game and be supportive of their team mates, coach and manager at all times.
- 6. All players wishing to be selected must attend the Selection Day on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May. Teams will be chosen based on attendance on this day. If players are unable to attend, they must email <a href="mailto:northernrangersinr@gmail.com">northernrangersinr@gmail.com</a> to explain their inability.
- 7. Players are to respect that coaches volunteer their time, and are required to attend all training sessions. **Training will commence on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July**. Players should arrive at training 10 minutes beforehand. Any player that continues to be late or absent can have their position revoked. All travelling players must commit to 2 training sessions as a minimum.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT 2023**

- 1. Players and officials are to adhere to all tournament rules at all times.
- 2. Never engage in disrespectful conduct of any sort including profanity, sledging, obscene gestures, offensive remarks, trash talking, taunting or other actions that are demeaning to your team mates, opposition players, officials or supporters.
- 3. Players and officials are to accept the referees' decision, and never argue.
- 4. Recognise that many officials, coaches and referees are volunteers who give up their time to provide their services. Treat them with the utmost respect.
- 5. Parents and supporters are to behave! Unsportsmanlike language, harassment or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 6. Officials are to conduct themselves in a manner at all times and in all situations, that shows leadership, respect for the game and the rules, and respect for those that are involved in the game players, officials, volunteers and the referees.
- 7. Coaches or Managers are to escalate any issues concerning the tournament to Casey Davis (Representative Co-ordinator), who in turn will resolve with the Tournament Director. No official is to directly engage Australian Oztag.
- 8. Please do not comment on any form of social media on anything relative to the tournament, teams, officials or the running there of.
- 9. The production and distribution of any unauthorised apparel is forbidden.
- 10. Any representative player or official who withdraws from the squad; all replacements must be approved by the Committee.

# We are responsible for the conduct of our association. Breaches to the above conduct will result in penalties, including but not limited to:

- Suspension of a player, parent or official from the upcoming Oztag Summer Competition.
- Suspension of a player, parent or official for the following Junior Nationals and/or Junior State Cup (2024)
- These penalties are in addition to any penalty which may be imposed by NSW Oztag or Australian Oztag.
